**AN ACT REQUIRING A MORE EFFICIENT USE OF OFFICE SPACE  
LEASED BY THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 59 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Public Works and the Office of Policy and Management
- 3 to (1) evaluate the state's current use of leased office space, (2) develop
- 4 a plan to renegotiate or terminate costly lease agreements, and (3)
- 5 develop a plan for consolidating the state employee workforce to
- 6 enable a more efficient use of office space, in order to achieve a savings
- 7 of at least fifteen per cent of the state's current payments for leases.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To streamline state government to achieve cost savings.
