**AN ACT CONCERNING DEPOSITS AND RECONNECTION FEES
CHARGED BY UTILITY COMPANIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any electric,
- 2 electric distribution or gas company that terminates service to a
- 3 customer for nonpayment from requiring such customer to pay a
- 4 security deposit or reconnection fee prior to reconnection of service
- 5 after the customer has fully paid any balance owed.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit utility companies from requiring a security deposit or reconnection fee from a customer as a condition prior to reconnection of service.
