**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION, USE, SALE OR
MARKETING OF MEXICAN SALVIA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 420b of the general statutes be amended to prohibit the
- 2 possession, use, sale or marketing of Mexican salvia in any form
- 3 including liquid or powder forms.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect state residents, especially children, by banning Mexican salvia, a plant that can be used as an hallucinogenic substance.
