**AN ACT CONCERNING RESIDENCY RESTRICTIONS FOR CERTAIN
SEXUAL OFFENDERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that no person
- 2 convicted of a violation of sexual assault in the first, second or third
- 3 degree against a minor may establish a residence on or after the
- 4 effective date of this act that is within two thousand feet of a public or
- 5 private elementary or secondary school or a facility providing child
- 6 day care services.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children by requiring persons convicted of the sexual
assault of a child to reside at least two thousand feet away from a
school or child care center.
