AN ACT ESTABLISHING A "ROADSIDE MEMORIAL" SIGN PROGRAM FOR PERSONS KILLED IN MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a "Roadside
- 2 Memorial" sign program within the Department of Transportation, in
- 3 memory of persons who have been killed in motor vehicle accidents;
- 4 that such program shall authorize the immediate family of any such
- 5 deceased person to purchase a sign bearing the name of such person
- 6 from DOT; that the family of such person shall be responsible for all
- 7 costs, including reasonable administrative costs, incurred by DOT for
- 8 the purchase, erection and maintenance of such signs.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a "Roadside Memorial" sign program in memory of persons who have been killed in motor vehicle accidents.
