**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES  
TO CHANGE CERTAIN ADDRESSES ON FILE WITH THE  
DEPARTMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) If the Commissioner of  
2 Motor Vehicles receives notification from the United States Postal  
3 Service that a person who has an identity card issued under section 1-  
4 1h of the general statutes, or a motor vehicle operator's license or a  
5 certificate of registration for a motor vehicle, all-terrain vehicle,  
6 snowmobile or vessel issued under any section of the general statutes,  
7 has changed such person's address with the United States Postal  
8 Service, and the commissioner determines that such person has not  
9 notified the Department of Motor Vehicles in accordance with section  
10 14-17a, 14-45 or 15-146 of the general statutes, the commissioner may  
11 send any mail related to such person's identity card, operator's license  
12 or certificate of registration to the address that is on file with the  
13 United States Postal Service and may change the address of such  
14 person in the department's records to the address of such person that  
15 is on file with the United States Postal Service.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section

**Statement of Purpose:**

To help the Department of Motor Vehicles maintain its bulk mail rate and to address the department's problem with significant amounts of undeliverable mail.
