**AN ACT INCREASING THE FINE FOR OPERATING A MOTOR
VEHICLE WITHOUT SUFFICIENT INSURANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-213b of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 the fine for operating a private passenger motor vehicle or a vehicle
- 3 with a combination registration without the security required by
- 4 statute or with insufficient security, from a minimum of one hundred
- 5 dollars and maximum of one thousand dollars to five hundred dollars
- 6 and one thousand five hundred dollars, respectively.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the fine for operating a private passenger motor vehicle or
a vehicle with a combination registration without the security required
by statute or with insufficient security, from a minimum of \$100 and
maximum of \$1,000 to \$500 and \$1,500, respectively.
