**AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTIES FOR IRRESPONSIBLE DRIVING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1        That the general statutes be amended to provide that motorists who  
2        accumulate six or more points on their motor vehicle operator's record  
3        in any eighteen-month period, or who are convicted of a drug or  
4        alcohol-related driving offense, or who refuse a chemical test, shall pay  
5        a driver responsibility assessment which shall be in addition to any  
6        other fines, penalties and surcharges assessed as a result of such  
7        motorists' behavior; and that the assessment amount shall be billed  
8        every year for a period of three years and shall be one hundred dollars  
9        per year for the first six points, thirty-five dollars per year for each  
10       additional point in excess of six, and two hundred fifty dollars per year  
11       for each conviction of a drug or alcohol-related driving offense or  
12       refusal of a chemical test.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase the penalties for irresponsible driving.
