**AN ACT CONCERNING NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE WITH A MOTOR VEHICLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-215 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any person operating a motor vehicle during the period that such
- 3 person's operator's license is suspended or revoked who is at fault in a
- 4 motor vehicle accident that results in the death of another person shall
- 5 be in violation of section 14-222a of the general statutes concerning
- 6 negligent homicide with a motor vehicle.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that the actions of a person with a suspended license who disobeys the law by continuing to drive shall constitute negligent homicide with a motor vehicle if that person is at fault in a fatal accident.
