AN ACT INCREASING PENALTIES FOR PERSONS WHO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE HAVING A SUSPENDED LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-215 of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any person convicted of operating a motor vehicle while such
- 3 person's operator's license is suspended shall, for a fourth offense, be
- 4 sentenced to a term of imprisonment of two years, one hundred fifty
- 5 days of which may not be suspended or reduced, and, for a fifth or
- 6 subsequent offense, be sentenced to a term of imprisonment of two
- 7 and one-half years, one year of which may not be suspended or
- 8 reduced.

Statement of Purpose:

To better protect citizens of the state from habitual offenders.
