**AN ACT CONCERNING OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A
SUSPENDED LICENSE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 14-215 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to provide that any person whose operator's license has been
- 3 suspended who operates a motor vehicle during the period of such
- 4 suspension shall, in addition to any fine or term of imprisonment
- 5 imposed, have such person's motor vehicle impounded for a period of
- 6 twenty-four hours for each previous license suspension and shall, for a
- 7 third or subsequent violation, be sentenced to a term of imprisonment
- 8 of which thirty days may not be suspended or reduced.

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance penalties for persons who continue to drive while their license is under suspension.
