**AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO
EXTEND THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE RENEWAL DATE FOR
CERTAIN INCARCERATED PERSONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Motor Vehicles, upon written request of an incarcerated person who
- 3 responds to a renewal notice for such person's operator's license, to
- 4 extend the expiration date of such person's license for two years or
- 5 thirty days from such person's date of release.

Statement of Purpose:

To give incarcerated persons an opportunity to renew their motor vehicle operator's license.
