**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Transportation  
2 shall determine the number of certificates of public convenience and  
3 necessity issued by the department for the operation of livery services  
4 and the number of motor vehicles authorized to provide such livery  
5 service under all such permits. The department shall review the  
6 demand for livery services in order to determine if sufficient  
7 certificates of public convenience and necessity have been issued to  
8 meet such demand, and shall report its findings and recommendations  
9 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
10 cognizance of matters related to livery services, in accordance with the  
11 provisions of section 11-3a of the general statutes, not later than  
12 January 11, 2012.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
