**AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPOSITION OF TOLLS ON NEW
HIGHWAYS OR HIGHWAY EXTENSIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Department of Transportation shall be authorized to
- 2 impose tolls on vehicles traveling on a new highway or new extension
- 3 of an existing highway in order to collect a portion of the state's share
- 4 of the cost of such new highway or extension; that revenue generated
- 5 by the imposition of any such toll shall only be used to fund the
- 6 highway or extension on which such toll is imposed, and that the
- 7 imposition of such toll shall be discontinued upon collection of such
- 8 portion of the state's share of such cost.

Statement of Purpose:

To secure a reliable funding source for any new highway or highway extension.
