AN ACT REQUIRING THE IMMEDIATE NOTIFICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND THE ACTION OF SAID DEPARTMENT WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN OUT-OF-STATE MOTOR VEHICLE CONVICTIONS OF PERSONS WHO HAVE A CONNECTICUT MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-111n of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 any person with a Connecticut motor vehicle operator's license who is
- 3 convicted of a serious motor violation in another state to notify the
- 4 Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) within thirty days and to
- 5 require the DMV to concurrently penalize such persons within thirty
- 6 days of receiving such notice.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the period of time that elapses from an out-of-state motor vehicle conviction of a driver licensed in Connecticut until such driver is penalized in the state.
