**AN ACT ENCOURAGING PRIVATE INVESTMENT IN THE
INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Departments of Transportation and Public Works and the
2 Office of Policy and Management may, under a competitive sealed
3 proposals procurement approach, solicit proposals and enter into
4 contracts with the private sector for design-build-finance-operate-
5 maintain or design-build-operate-maintain services involving the sale,
6 lease, operation and maintenance of a "transportation facility"; that
7 "transportation facility" means infrastructure, including roads,
8 airports, seaports, parking facilities, rail facilities, or similar facility,
9 that is open to the public and used for the transportation of persons or
10 goods; that unsolicited proposals may be considered, subject to a
11 competitive bidding process.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage private investment in the state's infrastructure.
