***AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION SYSTEM TRANSFER AND ARTICULATION  
AGREEMENTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2011*) The Department of Higher  
2 Education, in consultation with the constituent units of state system of  
3 higher education, shall review the status and content of the public  
4 institution of higher education system transfer and articulation  
5 agreements. Such review shall consider: (1) The sufficiency of such  
6 agreements or transfer and articulation agreements modified or made  
7 on or after July 1, 2011, (A) to ensure appropriate credit transfer  
8 against degree requirements within each constituent unit, and (B) to  
9 ensure appropriate credit transfer against degree requirements across  
10 the constituents units and identify any disparities between the transfer  
11 of credits from the same or similar program from different colleges or  
12 universities of a constituent unit to a college or university of another  
13 constituent unit, (2) the status or completion of common course  
14 numbering within the community-technical college system, and (3) the  
15 establishment of a common passing score for any student placement

16 test used within or across the constituents units. Not later than January  
17 1, 2012, the Commissioner of Higher Education shall report the  
18 findings to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly  
19 having cognizance of matters relating to higher education and  
20 workforce advancement in accordance with the provisions of section  
21 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require a study of the transfer and articulation agreements of the public institutions of higher education.
