**AN ACT REQUIRING THE ADMINISTRATION OF AN ULTRASOUND
PROCEDURE PRIOR TO THE TERMINATION OF A PREGNANCY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368y of the general statutes be amended to require a
- 2 health care provider who performs an abortion to administer an
- 3 ultrasound procedure for the health benefit of the patient prior to
- 4 engaging in any procedure that will terminate the pregnancy.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure the health and well being of an individual who decides to terminate a pregnancy.
