**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISPENSING OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON SUNDAY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 30-91 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2011*):

4 (d) The sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating  
5 under package store permits, drug store permits, manufacturer  
6 permits for beer or grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on  
7 Decoration Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day,  
8 New Year's Day [, Sunday] or Christmas [or, if Independence Day,  
9 Christmas or New Year's Day occurs on a Sunday, on the Monday next  
10 following such day] except that such sale or dispensing shall be lawful  
11 on any Independence Day occurring on a Saturday; and such sale or  
12 dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating under package store  
13 permits, drug store permits, manufacturer permits for beer and  
14 grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on any other day before  
15 eight o'clock a.m. and after nine o'clock p.m. It shall be unlawful for  
16 the holder of a manufacturing permit for a brew pub to sell beer for

17 consumption off the premises on the days or hours prohibited by this  
18 subsection. Any town may, by a vote of a town meeting or by  
19 ordinance, reduce the number of hours during which such sale shall be  
20 permissible. The sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor on Sunday in  
21 places operating under a package store permit shall be at the option of  
22 the holder of such permit.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2011	30-91(d)

To allow for the sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor on Sunday in places operating under certain permits.
