**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN ENERGY INDEPENDENT ECONOMY IN CONNECTICUT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2011*) On or before January 1, 2015,  
2 the Commissioner of Transportation shall convert not less than  
3 twenty-five per cent of the state's heavy fleet, including, but not  
4 limited to, any tri-axle and diesel powered vehicles, to liquefied  
5 natural gas and compressed gas fuel.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
