AN ACT CONCERNING RENEWABLE RESOURCE GENERATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2011*) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of the general statutes, an electric distribution company may
3 construct, purchase, own or operate a generation facility for Class I or
4 Class II renewable energy sources, as defined in section 16-1 of the
5 general statutes for the purpose of meeting state or federal renewable
6 resource portfolio standards, provided the capacity of such facilities
7 does not exceed five megawatts for each company. An electric
8 distribution company constructing or purchasing such generation
9 facility shall recover the costs of such investment and operation,
10 including a return on investment, in a nonbypassable charge as
11 determined by the Department of Public Utility Control in an annual
12 proceeding held pursuant to sections 16-19, 16-19b and 16-19e of the
13 general statutes.
