AN ACT CONCERNING CONDITIONS OF CONFINEMENT FOR PERSONS CONVICTED OF CAPITAL FELONIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Whenever any person is
2 convicted of a violation of section 53a-54b of the general statutes and
3 committed to the custody of the Commissioner of Correction, the
4 commissioner shall place such person in a maximum security
5 correctional institution and segregate such person from the general
6 inmate population of that institution for the duration of such person's
7 sentence.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require persons convicted of murders that carry the maximum sentence under state law to be confined in maximum security prisons and segregated from other inmates.
