**AN ACT PROVIDING IN-STATE TUITION TO CHILDREN OF  
IMMIGRANTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10a-29 of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 children of immigrants residing in this state to attend the public
- 3 institutions of higher education as in-state students for tuition
- 4 purposes.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase access to postsecondary education for the children of  
immigrants residing in Connecticut.
