AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE OF PRECIOUS METALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2012*) The Commissioner of
2 Consumer Protection, in consultation with the Commissioner of Public
3 Safety, shall adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter 54 of the
4 general statutes, to develop standards regarding the sale of precious
5 metals, including, but not limited, to jewelry made of gold, silver and
6 platinum. Such regulations shall include, but not be limited to, record
7 keeping and reporting requirements and positive identification of
8 persons selling such precious metals.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
