AN ACT CONCERNING ENFORCEMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNS ON CERTAIN COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 14-311 to 14-311b, inclusive, of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to provide that any police officer may enforce traffic control
- 3 signals and devices that the State Traffic Commission establishes in
- 4 any parking area for twenty or more vehicles or for any commercial
- 5 establishment having an exit or entrance on or abutting or adjoining
- 6 any state highway.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit police officers to enforce traffic control signals and devices established on certain commercial properties.
