**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF CONVICTED FELONS  
FROM RECEIVING STATE SOCIAL SERVICE BENEFITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to prohibit a
- 2 person convicted of a felony from receiving benefits under state
- 3 administered social service programs.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require that persons receiving state aid are law abiding citizens.
