AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPULSION OF STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN CONVICTED OF CERTAIN SEXUAL ASSAULT CRIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-233d of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 local and regional boards of education or expulsion hearing boards to
- 3 conduct expulsion proceedings whenever the board of education or
- 4 expulsion hearing board obtains information that a student has been
- 5 convicted of a crime involving a violation of section 53a-70, 53a-70a,
- 6 53a-72b, 53a-92 or 53a-92a of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide boards of education the authority to conduct expulsion hearings for students who have been convicted of certain sexual assault crimes.
