**AN ACT CONCERNING RIBBONS AND MEDALS FOR MEMBERS OF  
THE MERCHANT MARINE WHO SERVED IN TIME OF WAR.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 27-73e of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the Adjutant General shall award a ribbon and medal to each
- 3 member of the United States Merchant Marine, as defined in section 9-
- 4 25a of the general statutes, who served in time of war, and who (1) was
- 5 a resident of this state at the time he or she entered service with the
- 6 merchant marine, or (2) is domiciled in this state on the date of such
- 7 award.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To award a ribbon and medal to each resident of Connecticut who served in time of war as a member of the merchant marine.
