AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR THE FILM TAX CREDIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-217jj of the general statutes be amended to include
- 2 the following requirements in the film tax credit program: (1) Thirty-
- 3 five per cent of all union crews working on a state-certified qualified
- 4 production must be state residents, including core crew and day
- 5 players, (2) thirty-five per cent of all nonunion production and office
- 6 staff must be state residents, and (3) there must be parity in the wages
- 7 and benefits paid to state residents and to other similarly situated
- 8 employees on the production.

Statement of Purpose:

To require those availing themselves of the state film tax credit program to hire state residents and pay them on par with other employees.
