**AN ACT CONCERNING SLOPE FAILURES TO IMPROVED
PROPERTIES CAUSED BY COASTAL EROSION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22a-92 of the general statutes be amended to authorize
- 2 owners of improved real property that is adjacent to coastal or tidal
- 3 waters to protect their property from erosion and slope failures by
- 4 constructing structural solutions when necessary and unavoidable for
- 5 the protection of the improved property.

Statement of Purpose:

To broaden the nature of properties that may erect structural solutions in order to protect said property from erosion and eventual slope failure.
