**AN ACT CONCERNING CREDIT FILE MONITORING FOR VICTIMS OF
PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION THEFT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 36a of the general statutes be amended to require lending
- 2 institutions that inadequately safeguard a person's personal
- 3 identifying information to provide lifetime credit file monitoring to
- 4 such person in the event such information is lost or stolen.

Statement of Purpose:

To help victims of personal identifying information theft.
