**AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE DELIVERY OF INFORMATION  
TECHNOLOGY SERVICES TO PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Information  
2 Technology shall study issues concerning the delivery of information  
3 technology services to the community-technical colleges, the  
4 Connecticut State University System and The University of  
5 Connecticut and any efficiencies or improvements that can be made to  
6 such delivery. Not later than January 1, 2012, the Commissioner of  
7 Information Technology shall report on such study to the joint  
8 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of  
9 matters relating to higher education in accordance with the provisions  
10 of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
