AN ACT CONCERNING MOTOR VEHICLE NUMBER PLATES FOR ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 14-20b of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, at the request of any veteran
4 or member of the armed forces, as defined in subsection (a) of section
5 27-103, or the surviving spouse of such veteran or member, shall
6 register any motor vehicle owned or leased for a period of at least one
7 year by such person and shall issue a special certificate of registration
8 and a set of number plates for each such vehicle. The plates shall
9 expire and be renewed as provided in section 14-22. The commissioner
10 shall charge a fee for such plates which shall cover the entire cost of
11 making the same and which shall be in addition to the fee for
12 registration of such motor vehicle.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
