AN ACT DELAYING IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN EDUCATION MANDATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to permit local and regional
- 2 boards of education to delay the implementation of the provisions of
- 3 public act 10-111 until such mandates are fully funded by the state, and
- 4 to amend section 10-221a of the general statutes to permit local and
- 5 regional boards of education to delay the implementation of the
- 6 changes to the high school graduation requirements until (1) such
- 7 changes are fully funded by the state, or (2) for classes graduating in
- 8 2024, whichever is sooner.

Statement of Purpose:

To delay the impact of the unfunded mandates contained in the education reform act of 2010.
