AN ACT CONCERNING THE STUDY OF START-UP BUSINESS INCUBATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the joint standing
- 2 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 3 relating to commerce to study the feasibility and effectiveness of start-
- 4 up business incubators. Said study shall include, but not be limited to,
- 5 an examination of using vacant commercial properties, revitalizing
- 6 distressed communities, sharing technologies, providing state financial
- 7 and resource assistance, waiving licenses and fees for new businesses,
- 8 changing tax policy to spur job creation, and interacting with higher
- 9 educational and technical institutions.

Statement of Purpose:

To study the effectiveness and impact of state encouragement of start-up incubators for small businesses.
