***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A BUSINESS REGULATORY COMMISSION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a business
- 2 regulatory commission to (1) use a cost-benefit analysis to review all
- 3 proposed and existing regulations impacting state businesses, (2)
- 4 recommend repeal of any regulation for which the cost to businesses
- 5 outweigh the benefits, and (3) report conclusions annually to the joint
- 6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to commerce.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To create the business regulatory commission to review the state's regulations as they affect businesses.
