AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That subsections (g) and (i) of section 14-227a of the general statutes
2 be amended to provide that any person who is convicted of a first
3 violation of subsection (a) of said section shall, as an alternative to a
4 one-year license suspension, have such person's operator's license
5 suspended for six months and be prohibited for the one-year period
6 following completion of such period of suspension from operating a
7 motor vehicle unless such motor vehicle is equipped with a
8 functioning, approved ignition interlock device, as defined in section
9 14-227j of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the use of ignition interlock devices in drunken driving cases.
