**AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL INTERSECTION SAFETY SYSTEMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to allow a municipality to  
2 adopt and enforce an ordinance that regulates the placement and use  
3 of intersection safety systems within the municipal boundaries;  
4 provide for a civil penalty for a violation of an ordinance and allow a  
5 portion of the civil penalty to be applied to defray the cost of the  
6 installation, operation and maintenance of the intersection safety  
7 system and that the remaining funds be distributed: (1) With seventy  
8 per cent to be deposited with the municipality in which the  
9 intersection safety system is located; and (2) with thirty per cent to be  
10 deposited in the state General Fund; and to prohibit the: (A) reporting  
11 of a violation of an ordinance on a driving record; (B) use of a violation  
12 of an ordinance to determine rates for motor vehicle insurance; and (C)  
13 assessment of points under the point system by the bureau of motor  
14 vehicles for a violation of an ordinance.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To allow a municipality to operate intersection safety camera systems.
