**AN ACT SUSPENDING THE DRIVER'S LICENSE OF A PERSON
ARRESTED FOR DRUNKEN DRIVING WITH A CHILD IN THE
VEHICLE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 14-227b of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that any person arrested for operating a motor vehicle while under the
- 3 influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug, or both, while a child
- 4 under sixteen years of age is a passenger in such motor vehicle shall
- 5 have such person's motor vehicle operator's license suspended by the
- 6 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles during the pendency of the criminal
- 7 case, provided such person may be issued a special operator's permit
- 8 pursuant to section 14-37a of the general statutes for the sole purpose
- 9 of driving to and from such person's place of employment.

Statement of Purpose:

To suspend the license of a person driving under the influence with a child in the vehicle.
