**AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICATION ORDERS AND CONSERVED PERSONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to permit a person, who has
- 2 been appointed "conservator of the person" for a person who is
- 3 incapable of caring for himself or herself due to mental illness, to apply
- 4 to the probate court for an order that requires the conserved person to
- 5 take medication to treat such mental illness if the probate court
- 6 determines that such order is in the conserved person's best interest.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow a conservator to seek a probate court order that requires the conserved person to take necessary medication.
