**AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY ALERTS CONCERNING
ABDUCTED OR MISSING CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to specify the conditions when
- 2 a law enforcement agency disseminates an emergency alert and
- 3 information concerning the abduction of a child and to authorize an
- 4 alert when a child under seventeen years of age is reported to have run
- 5 away from home.

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify when an Amber alert may be given and allow such an alert in cases where a child has run away from home.
