**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT TECHNOLOGY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That municipalities be authorized to use photographic traffic
- 2 enforcement technology for the issuance of municipal citations; that
- 3 revenues collected by the Centralized Infractions Bureau, excluding
- 4 additional assessments required by statute, shall be paid to
- 5 municipalities; and that the number of registered-owner-presumed-
- 6 operator violations be increased.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To make hometown roads safer and provide local officials with the option to apprehend red-light traffic violators via camera technology.
