**AN ACT REQUIRING CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE TRAFFIC
COMMISSION OF CERTAIN APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO LOCAL
PLANNING AND ZONING APPROVALS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 14-311c of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2011*):

4 (c) The State Traffic Commission shall issue its decision on an
5 application for a certificate under subsection (a) of this section not later
6 than one hundred twenty days after it is filed, except that, if the
7 commission needs additional information from the applicant, it shall
8 notify the applicant in writing as to what information is required and
9 (1) the commission may toll the running of such one-hundred-twenty-
10 day period by the number of days between and including the date
11 such notice is received by the applicant and the date the additional
12 information is received by the commission and (2) if the commission
13 receives the additional information during the last ten days of the one-
14 hundred-twenty-day period and needs additional time to review and
15 analyze such information, it may extend such period by not more than

16 fifteen days. [The State Traffic Commission may also, at its discretion,
17 postpone action on any application submitted pursuant to this section
18 or section 14-311a until such time as it is shown that an application has
19 been filed with and approved by the municipal planning and zoning
20 agency or other responsible municipal agency.]

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2011	14-311c(c)

Statement of Purpose:

To require the State Traffic Commission to consider certain applications prior to local planning and zoning approvals.
