**AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTIFIED POLICE OFFICERS FROM  
TELECOMMUNICATOR TRAINING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 28-30 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2011*):

4 (d) The office shall issue a written acknowledgment of achievement,  
5 without participation in a telecommunicator training program, to (1)  
6 any person who, by reason of experience or specialized training  
7 demonstrates competence in the performance of telecommunicator  
8 training standards as developed by the office, or (2) any police officer  
9 certified by the Police Officer Standards and Training Council and  
10 certified as a medical response technician.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

***Statement of Purpose:***

To exempt police officers certified by the Police Officer Standards and Training Council and certified as medical response technicians from telecommunicator training and to avoid the expense of such training.
