AN ACT CONCERNING CHILD IDENTITY THEFT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 53a-129a of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2011*):

4 (a) A person commits identity theft when such person knowingly
5 uses personal identifying information of another person to obtain or
6 attempt to obtain [, in the name of such other person,] money, credit,
7 goods, services, property or medical information without the consent
8 of such other person.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To protect children by closing a loophole that excludes the use of personal identifying information of children to obtain or attempt to obtain, in the name of a third party, money, credit, goods, services,

property or medical information without such children's consent from the definition of identity theft.
