**AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) Notwithstanding the  
2 provisions of subdivision (6) of subsection (j) of section 21a-254 of the  
3 general statutes, the Commissioner of Consumer Protection shall, not  
4 later than July 1, 2012, adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter  
5 54 of the general statutes, concerning the transfer of electronic  
6 controlled substance prescription information from prescribers to  
7 pharmacies. Such regulations shall comply with electronic prescription  
8 transmission regulations of the federal Drug Enforcement  
9 Administration, 21 CFR 1300 et seq., as amended from time to time.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

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**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to adopt regulations concerning the transfer of electronic controlled substance prescription information from prescribers to pharmacies.
