AN ACT CONCERNING PHARMACEUTICAL AND PRESCRIPTION DRUG WASTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2011*) (a) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of the general statutes, each pharmacy, as defined in section
3 20-571 of the general statutes, shall dispose of any unwanted drug in
4 accordance with applicable federal laws and regulations.

5 (b) Each pharmacy, as defined in section 20-571 of the general
6 statutes, shall direct any person who receives any drug by prescription
7 from such pharmacy to dispose of any unwanted drug in accordance
8 with any standards recommended or established by the Department of
9 Environmental Protection.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
