AN ACT CONCERNING ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 19a-36 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2011*):

4 (b) [Notwithstanding any regulations to the contrary, the] The
5 Commissioner of Public Health shall charge the following fees for the
6 following services: (1) Review of plans for each public swimming pool,
7 seven hundred fifty dollars; (2) review of each resubmitted plan for
8 each public swimming pool, two hundred fifty dollars; (3) inspection
9 of each public swimming pool, two hundred dollars; (4) reinspection
10 of each public swimming pool, one hundred fifty dollars; (5) review of
11 each small [flow plan for] subsurface sewage disposal system
12 engineered design plan, two hundred dollars; [and] (6) review of each
13 large [flow plan for] subsurface sewage disposal system engineered
14 design plan, six hundred twenty-five dollars; and (7) review of each
15 proprietary leaching system, five hundred dollars.

16 Sec. 2. Subsection (c) of section 19a-332a of the general statutes is

17 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
18 *October 1, 2011*):

19 (c) [Notwithstanding any regulations to the contrary, the] The
20 Commissioner of Public Health shall charge the following fees for the
21 services of the department in connection with asbestos abatement: (1)
22 Notification of abatement, less than one hundred sixty square feet, one
23 hundred dollars; (2) notification of abatement, one hundred sixty
24 square feet or greater, one hundred dollars plus one per cent of the
25 total abatement cost, up to a maximum of five thousand dollars; (3)
26 revision of notification of abatement, twenty-five dollars; (4)
27 reinspections, one hundred dollars; [(4)] (5) asbestos alternative work
28 practice review, two hundred dollars; [and (5)] (6) notice of demolition
29 activities, fifty dollars; (7) revision of notification of demolition
30 activities, twenty-five dollars; and (8) review of request to conduct
31 asbestos abatement while school is in session, two hundred dollars.
