AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPACT ON MUNICIPALITIES OF THE INCREASED AGE OF JUVENILE JURISDICTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1, 2012, the
2 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance
3 of matters relating to the judiciary shall complete a study of provisions
4 of the general statutes that designate individuals sixteen and seventeen
5 years of age as children in delinquency matters, and determine which
6 revisions to the general statutes, if any, may be made to reduce the
7 fiscal impact on municipalities related to such provisions.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
