***RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A FULL-TIME UNICAMERAL  
LEGISLATURE.***

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 establish a full-time, unicameral legislature for the November 2016
- 3 election composed of sixty members, entitled the "General Assembly"
- 4 where one-half of the members shall have a term of four years and the
- 5 other one-half shall have a term of two years, provided no member
- 6 shall serve more than twelve years, and regular session shall be held
- 7 from January first to December thirty-first of each year.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To make the General Assembly a more effective oversight body, to save money by reducing salary, health care and pension costs and to professionalize the General Assembly.
